New members: All applicants must have passed a beginner's course recognised by the English Field Archery Association (EFAA). It is a condition of membership that you will be a member of the EFAA and be able to provide your EFAA membership number. Your WMB membership cannot be completed without this.

If you are an existing archer shooting under the rules of another recognised archery association, but have no experience of field archery, you will be required to accompany a club instructor on an introductory round of the WMB woods before applying for membership.

EFAA membership: Before shooting at White Mark Bowmen, you must obtain membership of the English Field Archery Association. Membership forms are available in the club hut or online at www.fieldarcher.com

Renewals: White Mark Bowmen and the EFAA annual membership is for a calendar year from 1st January until 31st December. Both allow one month's grace to renew for continuous membership. Please note that your EFAA membership expires 31st January. You will not be insured after this date and must not shoot until your EFAA membership is renewed.

Cub/Junior members: Cub members must be accompanied by, and under the supervision of, their parent/guardian at all times whilst attending the club. Junior members may attend unaccompanied only with the prior agreement of the parent/guardian and the club management committee. Please advise us if there are any special needs that we should be aware of.

White Mark Bowmen. Notes on membership

1. New members must have demonstrated their archery competency and familiarity with our range by attending and passing our beginners' course or an introductory session with a club instructor.
2. All shooting members shall hold and maintain individual membership of the EFAA.
3. Members must renew their club and EFAA subscriptions within one month of its expiry.
4. Any person up to the age of 13 years on 1st July shall be eligible to join as a cub member, provided that they offer consent of a parent or guardian.
5. All cub members up to the age of 13 years must, whilst attending the club, be accompanied and supervised by a parent or nominated guardian who holds current WMB Associate membership status.
6. Any person from the age of 13 to 17 years on 1st July shall be eligible to join as a junior member, provided that they offer consent of a parent or guardian.
7. All junior members up to the age of 17 years must, whilst attending the club, be accompanied and supervised by a parent or nominated guardian who holds current WMB Associate membership status. Junior members may, by prior agreement between their parent or guardian and the club, attend the club unaccompanied. The club will maintain and display a register of those junior members with these permissions.
8. Members must at all times abide by the WMB rules regarding the use of the facility and range. It is the responsibility of the member to be aware of and understand these rules. The current rules in force will be advised to new members and are displayed in the club hut.
9. Any conduct of members at the club which is deemed unseemly, objectionable, or liable to bring the club into disrepute, will be investigated by the committee in line with the disciplinary and complaints procedure as posted in the club hut.

Membership cards

All members should display their current White Mark Bowmen Membership Cards whilst using the range. Any person not doing so may be challenged

EFAA Membership/Record cards must be presented to the General Secretary, or their nominated deputy, at registration for any EFAA shoot. Failure to present a valid EFAA card will exclude the archer from participation in that shoot.
