## Membership application/renewal



**New members:** All applicants must have passed a beginner's course recognised by the English Field Archery Association (EFAA). It is a condition of membership that you will be a member of the EFAA and be able to provide your EFAA membership number. Your WMB membership cannot be completed without this.

If you are an existing archer shooting under the rules of another recognised archery association, but have no experience of field archery, you will be required to accompany a club instructor on an introductory round of the WMB woods before applying for membership.

**EFAA membership:** Before shooting at White Mark Bowmen, you must obtain membership of the English Field Archery Association. Membership forms are available in the club hut or online at [www.fieldarcher.com](http://www.fieldarcher.com)

**Renewals:** White Mark Bowmen and the EFAA annual membership is for a calendar year from 1st January until 31st December. Both allow one month's grace to renew for continuous membership. Please note that your EFAA membership expires 31st January. You will not be insured after this date and must not shoot until your EFAA membership is renewed.

**Cub/Junior members:** Cub/Junior members **must be accompanied by, and under the supervision of, their parent/guardian at all times** whilst attending the club. Those accompanying a Cub/Junior member must hold WMB and EFAA associate membership

## Notes on membership

1. New members must have demonstrated their archery competency and familiarity with our range by attending and passing our Beginners' Course or an Introductory Session with a club instructor.
2. Any person over the age of 17 years on 1st July shall be eligible to join as an **Adult** member.
3. Any person from the age of 13 to 17 years on 1st July shall be eligible to join as a **Junior** member with the consent of their parent or guardian. They must be accompanied and supervised at all times by the parent or guardian who accompanied them on the Beginners Course/Assessment and who holds current WMB Associate membership status.
4. Any person up to the age of 13 years on 1st July shall be eligible to join as a **Cub** member, with the consent of their parent or guardian. They must be accompanied and supervised at all times by the parent or guardian who accompanied them on the Beginners Course/Assessment and who holds current WMB Associate membership status.
5. All members shall hold and maintain individual membership of the EFAA.
6. Members must renew their club and EFAA subscriptions within one month of its expiry.
7. Members must at all times abide by the WMB rules regarding the use of the facility and range. It is the responsibility of the member to be aware of and understand these rules. The current rules in force will be advised to new members and are displayed in the club hut.
8. Any conduct of members at the club which is deemed dangerous, unseemly, objectionable, or liable to bring the club into disrepute, will be investigated by the committee in line with the disciplinary and complaints procedure as posted in the club hut.

## Security

It is the responsibility of all members to ensure the security of the site and facilities at all times. If you are the last member to leave the site, please check:

- The toilets are locked
- The hut is locked with the window shutters closed/secured and the gas/electricity turned off
- The gate at the end of the track is locked if the stables are unattended

All padlocks, in use or not, should be locked and scrambled when unattended.

## Use of the range

Arrows used on the range must carry the name of the archer and ideally identify their archery club ie: A.N.Other - WMB. Arrows found without such identifying marking will be recycled or disposed of.

All members may use the range for casual shooting (practice) 365 days per year with the following exceptions:

- On our 'official' shoot days. Members can join the shoot but must register before-hand on the day, usually between 9am and 10am
- On the afternoon preceding an 'official' shoot when the range will be closed for maintenance/preparation, usually from 1pm GMT or 2pm BST
- At any other time for events as notified to the members in advance

Our 'official' EFAA shoots are normally held on the 4th Sunday of the month and the 5th Sunday when it occurs. Specific shoot details are contained in the monthly 'What's on at White Mark' email newsletter, on the club website, posted on the notice board in the club hut and are published in the Field Archer magazine.

Members can only bring guests as non-shooting observers/walkers if their group is accompanied by a club instructor.

## Membership cards

All members should display their current White Mark Bowmen Membership Cards whilst using the range. Any person not doing so may be challenged.

EFAA Membership/Record cards must be presented to the General Secretary, or their nominated deputy, at registration for any EFAA 'Official' shoot. Failure to present a valid EFAA card may exclude the archer from participation in that shoot.
